#### **NOTES:**

BCC students who complete the Liberal Arts & Sciences / Professional Transfer associate's degree with at least 60 credits and a minimum GPA of 2.0 will be guaranteed admission into the Providence College SCE bachelor's degree in Liberal Studies AND the secondary-level Teacher Certification Program in history / social studies. Students must earn a grade of "C" or better to earn transfer credit for each course.

- 1. Providence College SCE will waive the \$55 application fee for students who meet the above requirements.
- 2. Students must fulfill the Providence College SCE's core curriculum requirements; complete the residency requirement of a minimum of 45 credits in Providence College SCE; and earn at least 50% of their major credits with Providence College SCE coursework.
- 3. Most students transferring with the Associate's in Liberal Arts & Sciences / Professional Transfer Option will need 60 credits to complete the bachelor's degree AND secondary level Teacher Certification Program in history / social studies.
- 4. Please note that two of the Social Science courses taken should be from the same discipline (e.g. sociology, psychology, etc.)
- 5. Because of the large number of electives permitted in this program, it is very important to consult with both BCC and PC SCE advisers regarding these electives in order to maximize your transfer credit into the B.A. Liberal Studies degree AND Teacher Certification Program for secondary level teaching in history / social studies. Some BCC elective courses may be used to fulfill the Liberal Studies major requirements in the areas of "Self," "Society," and "World."
