

hrough the new Guaranteed
Admission and Tuition Agreement
(GATA), you may qualify to be
conditionally accepted into PC's School of Continuing Education (SCE) while attending CCRI.

This means guaranteed admission into PC SCE and acceptance of your credits. You won't have to worry about wasting credits and money on courses that won't transfer.

Of course, price is another great reason to transfer to SCE. You can earn a PC degree at a price that's more affordable than most Rhode Island and Massachusetts four-year state schools. Through the GATA, you'd enjoy a 33% reduction in your SCE tuition.

What does this mean for you? Based on our 2017-18 tuition, your cost of a course would be reduced from \$1,050 to \$703.50. That's a savings of more than \$6,930 if you complete 60 credits or 20 courses at PC.

Plus, you'll experience these important benefits by enrolling in SCE:

- Personal advising and small classes with faculty who'll know you by name
- ♦ Up to 75 transfer credits accepted
- Part-time and full-time study with evening and online classes
- Scholarships and financial aid for transfer students



To take advantage of this opportunity, here's what you need to do:

- Meet with your CCRI advisor and apply before you earn more than 30 credits
- **Choose** an approved major from the list of approved transfer programs
- **Graduate** from CCRI with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher
